

INTRODUCTION

"The Road to Equality: Women's Quest for Voice and Dignity"

My quest to explore the true meaning of impact through the lens of the World's power women has led to the discovery of the story of the rise of women from an era where they were largely regarded as non-entities, to the gains of the past two centuries, and a decade evidenced by women securing the rights to vote and be voted into the highest levels of public office. As my quest continued, it was clear that the essence of my expedition would be lost without paying homage to two of the renowned matriarchs of women liberation, Alice Paul and Lucy Burns. How these two women changed the course of history for millions of others, is a question that motivated me to explore this story of the rise of extraordinary women who have shaped the course of history and civilizations.

Therefore, on the 30th of May 2023, I journeyed to Alice Paul Institute and Birthplace in Paulsdale, New Jersey to get first-hand experience and perspective into the life of the



Icon, Alice Paul. Whilst touring and walking on the grounds of the historic facility, words such as 'Resilient and Fearless' readily came to mind in a bid to describe these timeless women - Alice Paul and Lucy Burns. Their revolutionary role in securing the ratification of the 19th Amendment and women's constitutional right to vote and indeed in the suffrage movement, was not without very extreme hardships nor was it a walk in the park. Both

women faced diverse dimensions of cruelty, sacrifices that formed the rich history of women progress recorded so far.

Quincy, my amiable tour quide recounted that their revolutionary strategy of sustained dramatic, nonviolent protests characterised by colourful, high-spirited suffrage marches and songs, were met with different forms of physical and brutal attacks including daily pickets and arrests accompanied with brutal prison conditions. These led organised hunger strikes by women, which attracted stringent militancy measures of forced feeding. To date, it remains a mystery as to how it was difficult to break their spirit and stop them in their tracks despite the gruesome circumstances they faced. They remained true to the cause without throwing in the towel or breaking under pressure. continued loyalty and commitment were rewarded with the Hunger Strike Medal 'for Valour' (depicted in figure 1) by the then Women's Social and Political Union (WSPU).



Interestingly, there were striking differences between both matriachs. Burns was American and the diplomat who was more keen to negotiate whereas Paul was British and the feisty one, humorously regarded as the militant amongst the two women.

Regardless, such differences seemed to become a combined force that fuelled their common passion and fearlessness in the face of excruciating pain, resistance, and torture. Although they both received top education to the highest levels, they were driven by their determination to push back on the academic route to pursue their philosophy of "holding the party-in-power responsible" until they win full equality for women. This unique measure involved a revolutionary approach of withholding women's support from the political parties that were averse to suffrage, accompanied with a bold declaration that read-'support our bill for suffrage or we will make sure you don't get re-elected.'

As I assimilated this insightful information during my Paulsdale tour, I was struck by the impact of Paul and Burns in fighting for women's voice and dignity and paving the way for women in subsequent generations to confidently take on the reins of leadership in various spheres. Their bravery produced a rich legacy of women leaders who have worked hard across different sectors to redefine the true meaning of impact. Such impacttransformational focused leadership underpins the motivation of the team that produced this timeless collector's Item - the Global Power Women (GPW) Yearbook, and I am excited for the privilege to have led this effort, which is both timely and novel.

The GPW Yearbook therefore attempts to present the intriguing narrative that weaves the history of women's progress across centuries and generations, especially in the past decade. The book draws inferences from similarities between women's leadership attainments and approaches in the past centuries, and those who had or currently hold the reins of leadership. This is to inspire more women to begin to visualise the possibilities in making the decision to take on such roles and achieve such feats.

In this maiden Volume 1 edition, a strong narrative of the impact of women's leadership across diverse sectors and regions of the world is weaved into every page of this insightful book. Subsequent volumes will provide answers to address arguments on whether the number of women in leadership roles directly affect the magnitude of their leadership impact and influence or whether despite the few numbers, their leadership impact should

rather become a powerful motivation for more women to take up such roles that will in turn increase that number.
